

Technical college offers free dental care

As part of February's National Children's Dental Health Month, Lake Washington Technical College is hosting a dental care day for children from low-income families on Saturday, Feb. 9, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. The dental care day is being held at LWTC's campus dental clinic and organized by the Lake Washington Dental Hygienists' Society and LWTC's Dental Program.

Services being provided for local children include exams by dentists, x-rays, fluoride treatment and dental sealants. Local dentists, registered dental hygienists and LWTC dental program students will be participating in the dental care day.

The program is limited to the first 100 children, ages 6-13, on a first-come basis. There is a suggested donation of \$5 per child for services that normally would cost more than \$300 per person, but no child will be turned away due to an inability to pay.
