For a limited time, the Worker Retraining program at Lake Washington Technical College can now pay for tuition and books for anyone who needs training to avoid a layoff situation. The Washington State Board of Community and Technical Colleges re-authorized funding for working individuals who may be vulnerable to a layoff. The criteria for individuals to receive this funding are that they meet two of the following three requirements:

- Working, but the job description has changed so new skills are needed to avoid a layoff situation
- Have not achieved a degree with more than 45 college-level credits
- Working, but the job title is considered to be "not in demand"
