Lake Washington College Foundation Endowments Increase in 2007

Last year was a banner year for the Lake Washington College Foundation and the students and programs it helps support. In just one year, the Foundation's endowments increased \$150,000, from \$397,000 in 2006 to \$547,000 in 2007.

The Foundation provided more than 35 scholarships to Lake Washington Technical College (LWTC) students in 2007 and directly helped an additional 20 LWTC students through its Student Emergency Fund.

"It's so rewarding to see how the Foundation – through its supporters – makes a difference in so many students' lives," said David Akana, Lake Washington College Foundation executive director.

In 2007, the Foundation established three new scholarship endowments totaling more than \$44,000:
